2011 ENTRY FEES: \$2.00 per head/per class (Exemptions: Dam & Daughter, Get-of-Sire, & Exhibitor's Herd count as 1 head)

2011 STALL FEES: \$10.00 per stall (each stall holds approximately 2 animals) *Stalls are first come first served *

\$5.00 per stall will be returned if cleaned by exhibitor and inspected by a show chairperson prior to exhibitor leaving

Stall bedding will NOT be provided.

Food concessions will be available on the grounds from 10 a.m. until late afternoon.

General Rules:

- All goats must comply with the Michigan Department of Agriculture (MDA) requirements.
- If less than three animals in a breed section, sections may be combined.
- **No refunds.** Show organizers reserve the right to combine, cancel, or split classes as necessary.
- The show may be delayed or ended early due to severe weather.
- Ribbons will be given to 6th place. **Decisions of the Judge are final.**
- Horns optional for this open show.
- Registration papers are not required to participate at this event.
- All animals must be properly taken care of.
- Do not preregister for Grand and Reserve Champion classes.
- The show age is as of January 1st of current year.
- No camping will be allowed.
